

## Pueblo Central High School Foundation Academic Scholarship Application

One of the Pueblo Central High School Foundation's principal roles is to help provide graduates the opportunity to further their education beyond the hallowed halls of Central High School; therefore, the Pueblo Central High School Foundation is proud to offer scholarship opportunities to qualified graduating seniors from Central High School. Students seeking to obtain an associate's or bachelor's degree from any **two or four-year accredited** college or university may apply for this scholarship. This one-time scholarship is awarded during a single academic year following graduation from Central High School.

### **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

Qualified applicants **MUST SUBMIT AND COMPLETE ALL** of the items on the checklist below and return all paperwork by the announced deadline date.

- ✓ Completed Foundation Scholarship application
- ✓ Official copy of high school transcript with assessment scores (i.e. SAT, ACT, ASVAB, Accuplacer, etc.)
- ✓ Copy of acceptance letter from an accredited **two or four-year** college or university
- ✓ Complete resume following the Scholarship Criteria (see page 3 of application)
- ✓ **Three** letters of recommendation: one from a Central teacher, counselor, or administrator
  - Recommendation letters **cannot** be from a family member or a **currently seated** Pueblo Central High School Foundation board member (see page 2 of application).
  - Recommendation letters should describe the how the applicant demonstrates being a CAT (character, accountability, and total respect).
- ✓ A 250-300 word typed, double-spaced essay (following MLA format) answering the following prompt: ***As a graduating senior from Central High School, describe what being a Wildcat has truly meant to you? How has your experience at Central High School shaped you into the young adult you are today, and how will it benefit you in your future endeavors?***
- ✓ Student, parent/guardian, counselor, and principal signatures

### **TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP:**

The scholarship recipient must present the Pueblo Central High School Foundation Scholarship Committee with verification of enrollment at the accredited **two or four-year** college or university where the scholarship money will be used before this scholarship may be awarded. The first half of the award will be sent to the financial aid office of the college or university the student is attending. The funds will be in the student's name. In order to receive the second half of the award, the student must provide the Pueblo Central High School Foundation Scholarship chairperson with an official transcript of the first-term grades verifying that the student is in good standing with the college or university. If the student is not in good standing, the second half of the scholarship money will be retained in the Pueblo Central High School Foundation Scholarship Fund. **A letter to the student providing additional details of the scholarship will be given at a later date. Please keep this letter on file for continued direction.**

### **DEADLINE:**

All completed applications are due **ON OR BEFORE APRIL 2, 2020**. Please deliver applications to Central High School English teacher Ms. Shaynee Jesik (Rm. 428).
